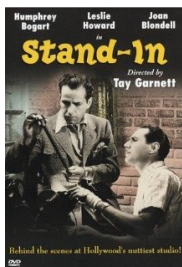
4 – 6 Oct 2014 The 39th Residential Film Weekend The Metropole Guesthouse, Katoomba.

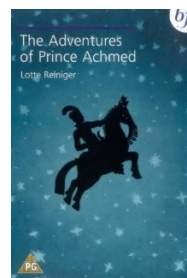
