HOW TO GET TO HAWKESBURY COLLEGE

The College is at Richmond about 70 kilometres from Sydney (about 1½ hours driving time). Approaching Richmond, turn into Bourke Street which leads directly into the main gates of the College. A sign at the corner of Bourke Street points to the College.

For those coming by train: Trains leave Central for Richmond quite frequently and cabs are readily available from Richmond Station. Trains sometimes stop at a small siding before the main Richmond station - this siding is about two blocks from the main gates of the College.

BOOKING IN

You will be able to book in and have your room allocated from 12.00 noon onwards on the Saturday. Note: No lunch will be provided by the College on the Saturday.

If you are not familiar with the parking areas, it is suggested that you drive to the main entrance and obtain parking details while booking in. There are two areas available for parking.

ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

Accommodation consists of single rooms complete with linen, soap and towels. Toilet and washing facilities are at the end of the building. Couples and groups can be allocated adjoining rooms providing they are among the earlier bookings.

Meals commence promptly and you need to be punctual. The times are:

BREAKFAST	-	8.00 a.m.
LUNCH	-	12.00 noon
DINNER	-	6.00 p.m.

Bar facilities are available at the Union, and as indicated on the programme there will be a number of coffee breaks and informal discussions. There are pleasant walks in the College surroundings, a swimming pool and a tennis court.

Screening times shown on the programme will be adhered to as strictly as possible.

The first screening will commence at 2.00 p.m. on Saturday and the last screening will conclude at approximately 4.00 p.m. on Monday. The programme schedule is on the back of the leaflet.
